Dear Parents/Guardians,

Saint Gregory School was approved by the Pennsylvania Department of Education to offer a *Flexible Instructional Day*. For the 2024-2025 school year, we are planning to implement the *Flexible Instructional Day* when inclement weather would impact students' safety traveling to school.

Saint Gregory School will have three (3) options when inclement weather affects a school day:

- 2-Hour Delay Day
- Flexible Instructional Day
- Closed Day

**On Flexible Instructional Days, students will remain at home for the day and work on assignments/homework that will be provided through the student paper assignments in the marked envelopes from your child's teacher that are coming home on November 14th!**

Teachers will be remotely working on *Flexible Instructional Days* during their regular school hours and be available via school email to support students and parents with classroom assignments. Students will have three (3) school days to complete assignments for the *Flexible Instructional Days*; which will qualify them to be marked present (for attendance purposes) for the day.

Remember, this day will count as a regular day of school.

When the school designates a *Flexible Instructional Day*, the Parent One Call System will notify parents/students and local television stations will announce the Flexible Instructional Days. We believe that with your support, the *Flexible Instructional Day* is a great alternative for student make-up days at the end of the school year.
